That song "Lights on the Hill" was a representation of his love of the music style and of Slim Dusty and his up bringing riding with pop in his big rig.

The years rolled along, Zac continued to hone his music and having played at venues in Tamworth and surrounds as a guest he decided to enter the Bingara Country Music Festival talent quest.

He won. Part of the prize was the recording of a single with Tamworth music studio owner and producer Rob Breese.

Now it's time for the debut release of "Hometown lights".

A song sourced by producer Rob Breese to compliment both Zacs vocal ability and an all-important trucking story line which is in Zacs bones.

This release comes in time for a return performance at the Channel Country Music Muster in Thargomindah [QLD] July 15 & 16, where he has been booked for the main stage following a whirlwind visit the previous year appearing on the walk ups.

Zac Anthony is now a road train driver in the Northern Territory and is here for the journey.
